Your letters of 16 August and 17 September 2007 refer.

We have sent our client copies of the materials that accompanied your letter of 16 August. Those documents do not, of themselves, disclose any wrongdoing by the Anglican Trust for Women and Children's representatives of the day. We have advised the Trust and Bishop John that far more detail of the events that surrounded the transactions would be required before any conclusion of wrongdoing could be reached.

We have raised one or two issues with our client for clarification and when we have received further instructions from the Trust and Bishop John we will revert to you. In the meantime we reiterate that Bishop John has no personal knowledge of the transactions concerned. Without his having a detailed knowledge of all the events surrounding the transactions, we cannot see any useful purpose being served by his attending a meeting with your client.
